

An Ordinance prescribing
certain regulations for let-
ting and making contract
with the city,

The Board of Trustees of
the City of Orlando do
ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Whenever, in the cases
provided by law, it shall be
necessary for the city to enter
into a contract with the
lowest permissible bidder
for any work to be done or
material or supplies to be
furnished, the Board of
Trustees of the city shall
proceed as in this ordin-
ance prescribed.

Sec. 2. Before making any con-
tract mentioned in the forego-
ing section, the said Board
shall publish, at least once
in some newspaper publit-
ed in said city, an advertise-
ment for proposals for do-
ing such work or furnishing
such material or supplies,

which said advertisement shall
describe the work to be done,
or the material or equip-
ment to be furnished, and
shall specify the time up
to which bids will be receiv-
ed, the time and place when
the same will be opened,
which shall be ^{at} some meeting
of the said Board of Trustees
at the place of their regular
meetings; also shall require
all proposals to be sealed,
~~delivered~~ ^{submitted} to the Clerk of
the City, ~~and~~ enclosed with
a statement that the same
are prepared for doing the
work of furnishing the ma-
terials of supplies described
in said advertisement ~~and~~
~~shall be accompanied by a~~
check payable to the order
of the President of said
Board and certified by some
responsible bank, for an amount
not less than ten per cent of
the aggregate of such ~~payments~~
or by a bond to the City for

~~That the amount of \$1000.00~~

a like amount, condition-
ed that the bidder must a-
ppear by his proposal in case
the same shall be accepted
which bond shall be signed
by the bidder, and two other
bonds shall justify in double
the amount of the same
and above all stating ex-
cept in

Sec. 3.

At the time and place
fixed for opening said
bids the same shall be
opened and declared by
the President of said Board,
provided ~~that no proposal~~
shall be considered unless
accompanied by the required
check or bond, and ~~provided~~
~~that~~ that said Board
shall have the right to reject
any and all bids. And no
abstract shall be awarded
except upon the affirma-
tive vote of at least three
members of the Board.
The bidder whose proposal
shall be accepted shall enter

1 into a written contract with
2 the City for the performance
3 of the work, or furnishing of
4 the materials or supplies,
5 in accordance with the bid
6 bid, and shall also execute
7 to the City a bond, in such
8 an amount as the Board
9 of Trustees may require, con-
10 ditioned for the faithful per-
11 formance of such contract;
12 which said bond shall be
13 required by two sureties who
14 shall jointly in double
15 the amount of said bond
16 over and above all statuto-
17 ry exemptions, ~~and shall~~
18 ~~such contract and bond shall~~
19 ~~be so executed, and af-~~
20 ~~terward, the check or bond ac-~~
21 ~~compraising the bid and pro-~~
22 ~~posal shall be held by the~~
23 ~~President of the Board, and~~
24 ~~the same, or the amount of the~~
25 ~~said, shall be returned to~~
26 ~~the bidder. But if the bidder~~
27 ~~refuses or neglects to abide~~
28 ~~by the proposal, when accepted~~

1 the check accompanying the
2 list ~~shall~~ and the amount
3 therein mentioned shall be
4 declared forfeited to the city
5 and ~~shall~~ be collected ~~at~~
6 ~~and~~ into the general
7 fund any bond as forfeited
8 shall be collected by the
9 necessary proceedings in the
10 proper court, or the
11 portion of any bid, the value
12 of bond forfeited may in the
13 same, shall be forfeited
14 to the bidder.
