

ORDINANCE No. 331.

An ordinance fixing the rate and levying the property tax for the fiscal year, 1903.
The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:-

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied on all taxable property within the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, a property tax for the fiscal year 1903 as

as follows, to-wit:

For the general fund, which shall include the street, sewer, and water fund, Seventy five cents on each \$100.00 of said property.

For library fund Eleven cents on each \$100.00 of said property.

For the interest and sinking fund of the storm water water bonded indebtedness, Thirteen cents on each \$100.00 of said property.

For the fire hall bonded indebtedness one cent on each \$100.00 of said property.

SECTION 2. The tax levied by the foregoing section shall be a ~~report~~ ^{report} once upon the assessment roll for the fiscal year 1903 by the clerk of said city.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
