

ORDINANCE No. 454

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

*authorizing the City Marshall to locate street vendors and
other upon the streets of said City.*

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whenever any person under any provision of Article ~~IX~~ **IX** ~~Nine (9)~~ of Ordinance Number 430, of said City, shall obtain a license entitling such person to the use of the streets of said City, the place to be occupied by such person under such license shall at all times be subject to location or designation by the City Marshal of said City, and he shall have the right at all times during such occupation of such streets to change the place of location from time to time as he may deem for the public good.

Sec. 2:- It will be unlawful for any person to use any portion of any street of said City at a place other than that located or designated by the City Marshal of said City as provided in Section One (1) of this Ordinance under any license obtained by any ~~such~~ person entitling such person to the use of such streets or any portion thereof.

Sec. 3:- Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

Sec. 4:- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
