

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA, TO CONTROL THE LOITERING OF PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS.

The City Council of the City of Redlands, California, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Every person under the age of eighteen (18) years who loiters about the public streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, parks or public places of the City of Redlands, California, between the hour of 10:00 o'clock P. M. and the time of sunrise the following day when not accompanied by his parent or legal guardian having legal custody and control of such person, or spouse of such person over twenty-one (21) years of age, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2: Every parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care, custody or control of any person under the age of eighteen (19) years who allows or permits such person to violate any provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the City or County Jail for a period of not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That it is necessary that this ordinance shall take effect immediately and be in full force upon passage and approval thereof by the City Council of the City of Redlands, and upon publication thereof, under the police, health and safety powers of the City of Redlands and to promote the same in this city, and the this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Redlands.
