

ORDINANCE No. 348

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
amending ordinance No. 303 thereof.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain, as follows:

Ordinance No. 303 of said city is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Any person who shall have, keep, establish or maintain any lunch wagon or lunch counter or place where tamales, lunches, meals or drinks are sold or furnished, upon any of the public streets, parks, alleys or roads in the City of Redlands, between the hour of midnight of any day and the hour of 5 o'clock P. M. of the following day, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50. or by imprisonment not exceeding 20 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
