## ORDINANCE No. 348

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS amending ordinance As. 303 through.

Section 1. Any person who shall have, keep establish or maintain any lunch wagon or lunch counter or place where tamales, lunches, meals or drinks are sold or furnished, upon any of the public streets, parks, alleys or roads in the City of Redlands, between the hour of midnight of any day and the hour of 5 0 clock P. M. of the following day, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50. or by imprisonment not exceeding 20 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
