

ORDINANCE No. 293.

An ordinance ordering a general ^{municipal} municipal election and further ordering that at such general election a Board of fifteen free holders shall be elected by the qualified voters of the City of Redlands, whose duty it shall be to propose within ninety days after such election, a charter for said City of Redlands, under and by virtue of section eight of article eleven of the constitution of the State of California, .

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It having been officially disclosed, ascertained, and determined, that the City of Redlands in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, is now a City containing a population of more than three thousand five hundred inhabitants, it is ordered that a Board of fifteen freeholders who shall have been at least five years qualified electors of said City of Redlands, shall be elected by the qualified voters of said City at the general municipal election herein and hereby ordered and called to be held in said City of Redlands, on the 14th day of April 1902, whose duty it shall be to prepare and propose, within ninety days after such election, a charter for said City of Redlands, under and by virtue of section 8 of Article Eleven of the constitution of the State of California, .

Section 2. It is hereby ordered that a general municipal election be and the same is hereby called to be held in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, on Monday the 14th day of April, 1902, for the purpose of filling the following offices of said City, viz:

1. Member of Board of Trustees;
2. Member of Board of Trustees;

5. Clerk;
6. Treasurer;
7. Marshal;
8. Member of Board of 15 Freeholders;
