ORDINANCE NO. 2108

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS ESTABLISHING A LITTER CONTROL FEE

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered under Health and Safety Code Section 5471 to charge for the provision of sanitation collection and control services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a litter control fee should be established to maintain the neat and clean appearance of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the rate established herein does not exceed the reasonable cost of providing the services outlined herein; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5471;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain:

Section 1. A bi-monthly fee of \$.40 for residential and commercial units is hereby established for litter control.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect as provided for by law.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it, or a summary of it, to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City.
