

ORDINANCE No. 352

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
providing that no prosecutions shall be had against witnesses in certain
cases.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No prosecutions shall be had or maintained, under any ordinance of said City of Redlands, against any person for or on account of any transaction, matter, thing or offense concerning which he may testify or produce evidence as a witness, on the part of the prosecution, in any case prosecuted against another person, nor for or on account of his presence at or participation in any act or proceeding as to which he may so testify, whether such transaction, matter, thing or offense occurred before or after the adoption of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
