

ORDINANCE NO. 344.

An Ordinance permitting imprisonment in the county jail for violations of city ordinances.

.....

The board of trustees of the city of Redlands do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. Any person sentenced to imprisonment or sentenced to pay a fine and in default thereof to be imprisoned, for the violation of any ordinance of the city of Redlands now in force or that may be hereafter adopted, may be imprisoned in the county jail of San Bernardino County by judgment so pronounced by the recorder or judge pronouncing sentence.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
