

ORDINANCE No. 349

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
amending section 270 of Ordinance No.281 of said city.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1:

Section 270 of Ordinance No.281 of the city of Redlands

is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec.270. (a) Every violation of the provisions of any ordinance of the city of Redlands wherein it is provided that the doing of the acts or things therein specified shall be unlawful, shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor.

(b) Any person convicted of a misdemeanor under any ordinance of said city, the minimum penalty for which is now fixed in a fine of not less than five dollars, shall hereafter be punishable by a minimum fine of not less than \$3.00, and not exceeding the maximum penalty provided for ~~such~~ such offense.

(c) Any person convicted of a misdemeanor, the penalty for which is not otherwise prescribed, shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail of San Bernardino County not exceeding ten days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

*Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect
from and after its passage.*
