

An Ordinance prescribing
certain police regulations,
and providing for the
peace, good order, and
safety of the City.

The Board of Trustees
of the City of Rockland, do,
ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. No person without visible
means of support or en-
ployment, and not seeking
and employment, shall ~~be~~
~~with~~ idly loiter about
the streets, avenues, alleys, or
public places of the City,
or stay in drinking saloons
or grogeries, or gambling
houses, houses of bad re-
pute, or subordi aerports, ~~or~~
shall trespass in the right of up-
on the private premises of others,
or shall beg upon the streets,
avenues or alleys or the city:

No person, shall make, do
or countermand, or assist
in making any improper
noise, disturbance, or breach
of the peace, or shall use
threatening, insolent, or abu-

duct in crowds in any of

lic places of the city the

No person shall unlawfully,
by any improper noise or
behaviors, disturb, or in-
terfere with any lawful
assembly or meeting
within said city or with
any place, further, or priv-
ate schools are held or

shall, by any order, or incident
kept alive, or profane
discourse, disrespect, or dis-
turb the solemnity of any
congregation or assembly
held for religious worship
within the City."

Sec. 3rd No person shall wilfully
any false alarm, or any
alarm to be used, any
sounding instrument, or
any device, noise, or
performance tending to
the collection of persons
in the streets, avenues, or
public places, or upon
the sidewalks, or as to
abstract the same to the
army or air or dis-
turbance of citizens or hard-
ens within the city.

Act 2 No person shall make ^{or permit} ~~make~~

Act 3

No person shall be drunk, or in a state of intoxication in or upon any of the streets, avenues, alleys, or public places of the city, or in any private house or place to the annoyance and disturbance of others.

Act 4 No person shall, in or about any railroad depot within the city, make any loud noise, or disturbance, or indulge in any boisterous level or in obscene talk or to the annoyance or disturbance of citizens or travelers.

Act 8. No person shall use or indulge in any game, sport, or exercise likely to scare horses, injure persons.

embarrass the passage of

Sec. 7 No person shall be guilty
of any lewd or indecent be-
havior in any public place
within the city, or shall ap-
pear therein in ^{an} indecent
^{or in a dress not belonging to his or her sex}
or lewd dress, or shall
make any indecent exposure
of his ^{or her} person, or
shall ^{within the city} exhibit, ~~show~~ sell or
offer to sell, or give away,
any indecent ^{scandalous} or lewd book
print, picture, ^{circular, poster, bill,} or thing or shall
exhibit ~~any~~ or perform
any indecent immoral or
lewd play or representation
~~within the city limits~~ calcu-
lated to excite scandal immor-
ality or disturbance of the peace
or public tranquility. Any person
violating any of the provisions of this
Section ~~shall~~ shall be guilty of a mis-
demeanor and upon conviction thereof
shall be punished by a fine of not more
than three hundred dollars or by not more
than ^{in the County Jail} ~~one~~ ^{or} ~~more~~ ^{than} 90 days

Dec. 9, No person shall throw any stone, or any other missile, upon, or at any building, tree, or other public or private property, or upon, or at any person in any street, alley, public place, in closed, or in closed grounds, or in or with any street, or for any public place within the City.

Dec. 10, No person, other than an officer of the law in the exercise of his lawful authority, or constable shall fire off or any gun, pistol, or fire-arm of any description within the city limits.

Dec. 11, No person shall lead or ride horse, mule, wagon cart, or other vehicle over or upon any sidewalk in the city, or shall draw or push any

wagon, cart, or other vehicle
thereon unless ^{necessarily} crossing
the same to go in, crossing
yard or lot; and no
person shall permit any
horse or mule which he may
be leading, or driving or
riding, or any wagon, cart,
or other vehicle which he
may be driving, connecting,
putting or driving, to stand
upon any of the crosswalks
within the city limits.

Dec. 12 The person shall erect, place,
or keep any building, shop,
store, booth, or shed, or other
or in front, upon any
street, alley, alley, public
place, or sidewalk within
the city limits, or shall place
or keep, or cause to be
placed, or left on any and
sidewalk, any box, barrel,
or other obstruction to the
free passage, so as to leave.

Sec. 13 It shall be the duty of
the marshal of the city ~~to~~
or any police officer ^{therein}
at all times of the day and
night to preserve the public
peace, prevent crime, protect
the rights of persons and
property, guard the pub-
lic health, preserve order,
remove nuisances from
any of the streets, avenues,
alleys, or public places
within the city, and arrest
all persons found therein
violating any law, or ord-
inance of the city or aiding
or abetting in any such
violation, and all persons
found therein in derus-
sions circumstances;
and he shall detain the
persons so arrested in

custody until they can
be brought before the Recor-
der of the city, or some "mag-
istrate".

Sec. 14.

Any violation of the pro-
visions of this Ordinance, set
herein before provided for,
shall be a misdemeanor,
and any person convicted
thereof shall be punished
by a fine of not more
than 100 dollars, nor less
than 50 dollars, or by impris-
onment in the County Jail or
city prison for not more
than thirty days nor less
than five days.

This Ordinance shall
take effect from and af-
ter the date of its passage.
