

ORDINANCE No. 461.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS *Fixing the*
Rate and Levying the Property Tax for the Fiscal year
1909.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, California, a property tax for the fiscal year 1909 as follows:

For the general fund, which shall include the street, sewer and water fund, ~~ninety~~ *ninety* cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the library fund, twelve ~~cent~~ *and one-half* cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the interest and sinking fund of the storm water bonded indebtedness, eight ~~and one-half~~ *and one-half* cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For street work bond fund, one cent on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the fire hall bonded indebtedness, ~~3/4~~ *3/4* cent on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the municipal improvement bonded indebtedness, ~~Eight~~ *Eight* cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the special municipal bonded indebtedness, ~~5/8~~ *5/8* cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For the park bonded indebtedness, three cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
