

1 An Ordinance for the protec-
2 tion of hose belonging to the Fire
3 Department of the City.
4

5 The Board of Trustees of the
6 City of Cleveland do enact in
7 as follows :-

Sec. 1. Wherever, either for the purpose
9 of extinguishing any fire in the
10 City, or to save any property
11 therein from destruction by fire,
12 or to test the hose of said City,
13 or the hydrants thereof, any
14 members of the fire department
15 of the City shall have stretched,
16 or laid across, or on, or over, any
17 of the streets, avenues, alleys,
18 or other public places of said
19 City, any portion of such said
20 hose, it shall be unlawful to
21 drive, or lead, or draw over or
22 upon, or on to, such hose so stretch-
23 ed or laid down as aforesaid,
24 any horse or horses or mules or
25 any wagon, cart, buggy, or car-
26 riage of any description, or any
27 of the wheels thereof.

1 shall be and the same hereby
2 is declared to be a misdemeanor,
3 and shall be punished by
4 a fine of not more than
5 ~~fifty~~ ^{twenty} dollars, nor less than
6 five dollars, or by imprisonment
7 in the City Prison, or
8 County Jail for not more
9 than ~~two~~ ^{thirty} days, nor less than three
10 days, or by both such fine
11 and imprisonment.

13 take effect from and af-
14 ter the date of its passage.
