

Ordinance No 58.

An Ordinance for the protection
of certain public property.

The Board of Trustees of the City
of Redlands do ordain as follows:
Sect. 1. No person shall drive or lead
any horse, or animal of burden,
upon or across any park, square,
or public grounds of the City of
Redlands, except upon the roadways
thereof, and except where ~~it~~ he-
cessary to cross a sidewalk in go-
ing to or coming from private prem-
ises.

Sect. 2. No person shall water a horse,
or any other animal, at any pub-
lic fountain, nor shall dip out
or carry away from the basin
of any such fountain, nor shall
in anywise meddle with such foun-
tain basin, or water further than
may be necessary to obtain a
drink therefrom by such person.

Sect. 3. No person shall destroy, or cut, or
break any tree, plant, or shrub
growing upon any park or pub-

penalizing provisions is hereby de-
clared to be a misdemeanor, and
any person convicted thereof shall
be punished by a fine of not less
than five dollars, nor more than
twenty-five dollars, or by im-
prisonment in the city prison for
not less than one day, nor more
than five days.

This Ordinance shall take
effect from and after the date
of its passage.
