ORDINANCE NO. 1877

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1594 WHICH PROVIDED FOR AND CREATED A PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF REDLANDS

WHEREAS, on October 19, 1976, the City Council of the City of Redlands adopted Ordinance No. 1594 which provided for and created a Public Works Commission consisting of five (5) members in and for the City of Redlands; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Redlands to broaden the representation of the membership of the Public Works Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Section Two of Ordinance No. 1594 be amended to reflect that the Public Works Commission shall consist of seven (7) members.

SECTION TWO: That the additional two members of the Public Works Commission be appointed from the City Council from City residents at large for the following terms:

One member for a term of two (2) years. One member for a term of three (3) years.

Thereafter, the respective successors shall be appointed by the City Council from City residents at large for terms of three (3) years.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION THREE}}\colon$ This ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause it to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this City.
