

An Ordinance punishing  
for the punishment of con-  
tain misdemeanors;  
The Board of Trustees of  
the City of Orlando  
do enact as follows:

Sec. 1.

Every violation of the provision  
of any Ordinance of the City  
of Orlando shall be and  
the same hereby is declared  
to be a misdemeanor,

Sec. 2.

Any person convicted of a  
misdemeanor, the penalty for  
which is not otherwise pre-  
scribed, shall be punished  
by a fine of not more than  
fifty dollars nor less than  
five dollars, or by imprison-  
ment in the County Jail or City  
Prison for not more than 20  
days nor less than five days  
at the discretion of the  
magistrate.

Sec. 3.

Every judgment of the Recorder  
of the City imposing a fine  
for the violation of any  
ordinance shall also direct  
that the party so fined

shall be imprisoned until  
such fine shall be paid, or  
satisfied at the rate of one  
day's imprisonment for ev-  
ery dollar of the fine.

Sec 4. Any ~~small~~ person im-  
prisoned for violation of any or-  
dinance of the City shall be  
required to labor on the streets  
or other public property or  
works within the City at the  
rate of one day's work for  
every day of imprisonment such  
person shall have to receive, and  
it shall be the duty of the  
marshal of the City to en-  
force the provisions of this  
section.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance shall  
take effect from and af-  
ter the date of its passage,
