

ORDINANCE NO. 988

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 910 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DISPENSING OF MOTOR FUELS IN FILLING STATIONS, GARAGES AND PUBLIC SERVICE STATIONS."

The City Council of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section One. Ordinance No. 910 of the City of Redlands, entitled: "An Ordinance Regulating Dispensing of Motor Fuels in Filling Stations, Garages and Public Service Station," adopted September 15th, 1949, is hereby repealed.

Section Two. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Section Three. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, the newspaper hereby designated for that purpose.
