

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 939 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS, COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THAT THE ATMOSPHERIC PURITY AND FREEDOM OF THE AIR HAS BEEN CONTAMINATED THROUGH THE USE OF ORCHARD HEATERS AND OTHER METHODS OF HEATING ORCHARDS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE, SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF PERMITS; THE PROHIBITING OF THE USE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF HEATERS AND METHODS OF HEATING; METHODS OF APPEAL; PROVIDING FOR FEES AND PENALTIES," BY AMENDING A PORTION OF A SECTION AND BY ADDING A SECTION THERETO.

The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain as follows:

Section one: Ordinance No. 939 entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, Declaring that the Atmospheric Purity and Freedom of the Air Has Been Contaminated Through the Use of Orchard Heaters and Other Methods of Heating Orchards; Providing for the Issuance, Suspension and Revocation of Permits; the Prohibiting of the Use of Certain Types of Heaters and Methods of Heating; Methods of Appeal; Providing for Fees and Penalties," is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph one of Section IX of said Ordinance, entitled Class III Heaters Designated, Temporary Permits and Progressive Elimination shall be amended so that the first orchard heater listed shall be changed to and defined as Hy-Lo Hot Blast with a maximum Burning Rate of Fuel in Pounds per Hour of six pounds, in the place and stead of the Hy-Lo Double Stack heater.

That a new paragraph be added to said Ordinance, entitled Section XIXA, and to read as follows:

Section XIXA. In the event a contract is entered into between the City of Redlands and the County of San Bernardino for the enforcement of this Ordinance pursuant to the Provisions of Government Code, Sections 51300 to 51308, then in such event the Agricultural Commissioner of the County of San Bernardino shall serve in the place and stead of the City Manager in issuing permits for orchard heaters and in the regulation thereof, and shall have the same authority as given to the said City Manager to issue permits and regulate the same as hereinbefore set forth, including the enforcement of this ordinance.

Section two: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this city.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.
