

An ordinance regulating the making of any excavations or digging for any purpose in any of the streets, canals, lanes, alleys or public places of the city of Redlands.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No person shall dig or make any excavation in any of the streets, canals, lanes, alleys, public parks, or public places in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, except under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets of said City; without first giving twenty four hours notice in writing thereof to said Superintendent of Streets, stating the name or names of the person, firm, corporation or association causing any such work to be done, and the names or name of the plumber, contractor or person actually performing or to perform said work, and the purpose for which and the place where said work is to be done, all which notices must be filed and preserved by said Superintendent of Streets in his office.

Section 2. Every person, plumber, contractor, firm, corporation or association digging or making any excavation or causing the same to be done in any of the places mentioned in section one of this ordinance shall restore every such place of digging or excavation to as good and perfect condition for use as such place was before such digging or excavation and maintain in all respects as the same was previous thereto unless otherwise directed by said Superintendent.

admirance is purchasable by a fine of not less than \$10⁰⁰ nor more than \$100⁰⁰ to be enforced and collected by the Recorder of said City for ending in the Recorder's Court said City; and every person firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this admirance shall pay for each every person: license or privilege held from said Recorder \$5 as being an excessive and which said person shall be declared by said Board of Com. for each violation at any time.
