

ORDINANCE No. 243

An ordinance ordering the construction of public sewers on portions of Fourth Street, Citrus Avenue, Continuation of First Street, First Street, and Eureka Street, including all intersections of streets along said portions.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, do ordain as follows:

Section 1, That the street work herein described is required by the public interest and convenience, and the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, hereby orders the following work to be done in said City, to wit:

The construction of a public sewer in, along and through Fourth Street, Citrus Avenue, Continuation of First Street, and First Street, in said City, along the line hereinafter particularly specified and described, including all intersections of streets along said line.

The description of the line of said sewer is as follows: to wit:-- Beginning at a point in the center line of Fourth Street, on line with the northerly boundary of Fern Avenue; thence along the center line of Fourth Street North thirty-four degrees (34) West two thousand and sixty-nine and two tenth (2069.2) feet to a point in the North line of Vine Street; thence by curve to the right with a radius of sixty-six (66) feet, thirty-eight (38) feet to the center line of Fourth Street; thence North along the center line of Fourth Street two hundred and six (206) feet; thence by curve to the left with a sixty-six (66) foot radius eighty-seven (87) feet to the center of Citrus Avenue, at a point twenty-five (25) feet West of the West line of Fourth Street. (The sewer on the above described line is to be constructed of sewer pipe of eight(8) inch inside diameter) Thence with

(694.1) feet to the northerly line produced by the continuation of First Street; thence west fifteen and five tenths (15.5) feet; thence by curve to the right, with a one hundred (100) foot radius fifty-one (51) feet; thence along the continuation of First Street North sixty degrees (60°) west one hundred and forty-four (144) feet; thence by curve to the right, with a one hundred (100) foot radius, one hundred and two (102) feet to the center line of First Street; thence North along the center line of First Street one hundred eighty-three and five tenths (183.5) feet to present manhole situated thirty (30) feet North of the center of First and State Streets.

Also the construction of a public sewer in, along and through Eureka Street in said city, including all intersections of streets along the line hereinafter next

particularily described, as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point in the center line of Eureka Street, on a line with the northerly line of Fern Avenue; thence North thirty-four degrees (34°), west along the center line of Eureka Street, crossing the intersection of Clark Street and Olive Avenue twenty-five hundred twenty-nine and six tenths (2529.6) feet; thence by curve to the left with a sixty-six (66) foot radius eighteen and four tenths (18.4) feet; thence across Brookside Avenue and the south side of Citrus Avenue North forty-nine degrees (49°) west one hundred thirty-six and two tenths (136.2) feet to the center line of Citrus Avenue at a point opposite the center line of Second Street; said last mentioned line of sewer pipe along said Eureka Street

All said sewers shall be constructed of salt glazed vitrified clay pipe and with manholes and lamp holes of brick, iron and cement.

All of said sewers to be constructed under the direction and to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets of said City, and in accordance with the Specifications on file in the office of the City Clerk, said Specifications being numbered 6, adopted October the 12, 1898.

Section 2, The Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which this ordinance and notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals, shall be published in the manner and form and by the persons required by law.

Section 3, The City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to post conspicuously for two weeks, on or near the chamber door of the council, in the manner and form required by law, a notice, with specifications, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work; and said Clerk is hereby directed to publish for two weeks in the manner and form required by law, a notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted or on file, in the said newspaper hereby designated for that purpose as aforesaid. Said notice shall require a certified check or bond, either, as prescribed by law, and for an amount not less than 10 per cent. of the aggregate of the proposal. Said clerk is also hereby directed to publish this ordinance for two days in the

purpose as aforesaid.

Section 4, This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
