Section Two: That service from the city sewerage system to premises outside the city limits shall be made at the discretion of the City Council and the owner shall first pay a frontage charge of (3) three dollars per front foot with a minimum charge of \$300 per connection.

Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage in the manner and form required by law.

Section Three: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Redlands.
