

ORDINANCE No. 369

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
RELATING TO SIGNS ALONG OR OVER STREETS.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The placing, erecting and maintenance of signs, sign posts, bulletin boards and devices of a like character along, over and upon the public streets and places in the City of Redlands has become, and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation to extend, suspend, erect, place or maintain, or cause or permit to be extended, suspended, erected, placed or maintained, any sign board, sign post or sign device of any character, or bulletin board or post or similar device over, along or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley or place in the City of Redlands; provided, however, that the provisions hereof shall not apply to any sign or sign board which is permanently fastened against the surface of the building, and no portion of which is less than twelve feet above the surface of the sidewalk or extends less than 18 inches beyond the surface of the building, or to any sign or sign board which is permanently fastened against the surface of such building and does not extend more than six inches beyond such surface, or to any sign or sign board which conforms and is permanently fastened to the exterior contour surface of any bay-window, or to any sign painted upon the surface of any cloth awning, or to any sign which is so constructed as to be part and parcel of any wood or iron porch or awning which is part of and permanently attached to any building; but this is not to be construed as applying to any sign board which is independently annexed to or erected or placed upon any such porch or awning, or which extends beyond or below such porch or awning.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not over \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding ten days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 1st day of July 1905.
