

Ordinance No. 246

An ordinance levying a property tax for the year 1900.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby levied on all the taxable property of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, a property tax for the year 1900, as follows to wit:

That the general fund, which shall include the street, sewer, and water funds, sixty-five cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

For library fund, ten cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.
And on the interest and sinking fund of the storm water bonded indebtedness, twenty three cents on each one hundred dollars of said property.

Section 2. The taxes levied by the foregoing section shall be apportioned upon the Assessed Roll for the year 1900 by the Clerk of said City. He shall compile and enter upon said Roll, in a separate money column, the respective sums, in dollars and cents, respecting the fractions of a cent, to be paid as a tax on the property therein enumerated, and foot up the columns showing the total amount of such taxes and the column of total
