

ORDINANCE NO. 110.

An Ordinance levying a property tax for the year 1900.

That the Board of Aldermen of the City of Redlands do ordain
as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby levied on all the taxable
property of the City of Redlands, in the County of San Ber-
nardine, State of California a property tax for the year 1900
as follows, to wit:

For the purpose of this ordinance shall include the same as
assessed and prior to 1900. *Sixty-five* cents on each one hundred
dollars of said property.

For Library fund *Eight* cents on each one hundred
dollars of said property.

For the interest and sinking fund of the bonds issued
under authorization, *Twenty-seven* cents on each one hundred
dollars of said property.

Section 2. The taxes levied by the foregoing section
shall be apportioned upon the Assessment roll, for the year
1900, by the Clerk of said City. He shall compile and enter
upon said roll, in a separate money column, the respective

Foot up the column showing the total amount of such taxes
and the column of total value of property, in said city.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and
after its passage.
