

Ordinance No 8

An Ordinance granting to the Sunset Telephone Company, the right to erect, maintain and operate a telephone line upon and over the streets, avenues and alleys of the city of Redlands.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, do ordain as follows,

Sec. 1. The right is hereby granted to the Sunset Telephone and Telegraph Company, to erect, maintain and operate upon, along and over, the streets, avenues and alleys of the city of Redlands a telephone line, in placing the poles and wires necessary therefor, for the period of ten years from and after the date of the passage of this ordinance.

Sec. 2. The poles used in said Telephone line shall be of standard, not less than four by six inches in thickness and shall be set in the sidewalk next to the curb-line when erected in any street or avenue; and when erected in any alley paid poles shall be set next to the boundary line of such alley, provided that the poles upon any one street, avenue or alley shall

not be less than one hundred and
feet apart, and pro-
vided further that but one set
of poles shall be placed in any
street, avenue or alley with out
a special permit first obtained
from the Board of Trustees of said
city of Oakland. And all said
poles shall be securely and
firmly fastened in the ground,
and shall be so kept,
and whenever any pole shall, from
any cause, become insecure or li-
ble to break or fall, it shall
upon due notification from
the Superintendent of Streets of
said city be immediately replaced
by a good and secure pole by ~~the~~
the guarantee of the applicant and
at its expense, and all poles set
within a distance of one mile
from the point where the center
line of State Street intersects the
center line of Range Street in
said city, shall be surfaced
and painted from the top to the bottom
the ground.

Art. 3, The poles used in said Telephone
line shall be unobstructed at a uniform
height of twenty three feet, ^{above the level of the ground} when sketched
across any ~~streets~~ ^{avenue or alley,}
and ~~electrical~~ ^{at a height of}
except in ~~public~~ ^{public} portions i.e. from U.S. City
fire limits, there 30 ft.

Amend Section 1 of Ordinance
granting franchise to Lehigh
Telephone and Telegraph Com-
pany so that said section shall
read as follows to wit:

Sec. 1. The right is hereby granted
to the Lehigh Telephone and
Telegraph Company to erect,
maintain, and operate wires,
~~and~~ along and over the streets,
Avenues and alleys of the City
of Allentown, a Telephone line, in-
cluding the poles and wires ne-
cessary therefor, for the period
of ten years from and after the
date of the passage of this Or-

dinance, ~~Provided~~ ~~that~~
~~where poles are already erected~~
in any street or ~~avenue~~, no
poles shall be erected for the
entire distance from the cross
street or Avenue to the other
cross street or Avenue between
which such pole is erected
except in the State, and Orange street,
where no pole shall be erected upon
that part of any street or
Avenue upon or over which
~~any~~ a franchise has been
heretofore granted to any
Telegraph or Telephone company,
or upon which, on either side,

piece of pole. and all poles shall be securely and firmly planted in the ground, and so planted as to remain in as near by an exact upright position as possible, and shall be kept so planted, and whenever any pole shall, from any cause, become insecure or in danger of breaking or falling, the owner of the aforesaid right shall, upon due notification from the Superintendent of Streets of said City, immediately replace, at the expense of said grantee, each pole with a good and secure pole. and all poles shall be surfaced or planed, and painted from the top thereof to the ground.

Amend Section 3 of said Ordinance so that it shall read as follows; Section 3, the wires used in said Telephone line shall be suspended at a uniform height of not less than twenty ~~feet~~ feet above the level of the ground within the fire limits of the city, and elsewhere at a uniform height of not less than ~~fifty~~ feet above the level of the ground,

in ~~less than~~

seventeen feet above the level of the ground.

Sec. 4. all work hereunder in the construction and repairing of said Telephone Lines shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets of said city; and all streets, avenues and alleys upon which work shall be done shall be sealed to the same grantee of this right to the same order and condition in which they were prior to said work.

Sec. 5. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to prevent the power City or Recland from commencing grading, paving, blanking, repairing or ~~blanking~~ ^{clearing} any street, avenue or alley, or clearing the same in front or ~~thereof~~ ^{thereon}, or from constructing or repairing sidewalks or gutters thereon.

Sec. 6. all proceedings of the grantee of this right, under this ordinance shall be subject to any ordinance relative to the same that may hereafter be passed by the Board of Trustees of said city.

Sec. 7. The foregoing rights and privileges are granted subject to the

pregain conditions, and a failure
to observe any of said condi-
tions shall result a forfeiture
of said rights and privileges.
Sec. 8. This Ordinance shall take
effect from and after the date
of its passage.
