

ORDINANCE NO. 1739

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING ORDINANCES NOS. 1441 AND 1493 AND CHAPTER 59 OF THE REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE, ADOPTING AND PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE WATER DIVISION OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS does ordain as follows:

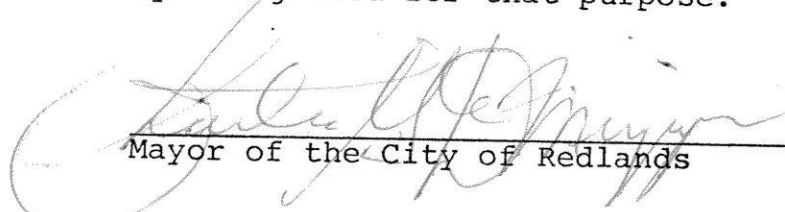
SECTION ONE: That Section 24 of Ordinances Nos. 1441 and 1493 and Section 59121 of the Redlands Ordinance Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

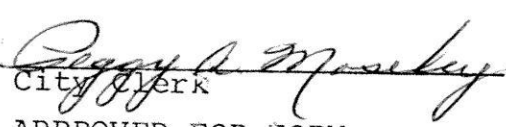
§ 59121. PREPAYMENT. The Water Division shall require a prepayment from all applicants who have not established credit. Established credit is defined as one year of service with a satisfactory payment record. This prepayment shall be in the amount of \$35.00 or a sum equal to three times the cost of the average or estimated monthly service rendered. The prepayment shall be refunded at the end of one year without interest, or at an earlier date if the consumer orders the service discontinued, provided that the water bills have been paid in full.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper hereby designated for that purpose.

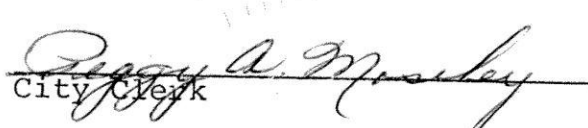
