## ORDINANCE NO. 1837

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING THE REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE, ARTICLE 407, WEAPONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Section 40701 of the Redlands Ordinance Code be amended to read as follows:

§ 40701. CARRYING CONCEALED WEAPONS. It is unlawful for any person within this City to carry concealed, upon any street or any public place, any pistol or revolver without first obtaining a permit to do so from the Chief of Police.

.1 APPLICATION FEE NOT REFUNDABLE. At the time of making application for a concealed weapon permit, a non-returnable fee of three dollars (\$3.00), in addition to the State of California costs for the processing, shall be paid to the City Treasurer to cover the cost. Said fee shall be paid for both original and renewal applications. (1469)

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this city.
