

ORDINANCE NO. 1134

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1000 OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS BY ADOPTING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO ORDINANCE NO. 1124.

The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain as follows:

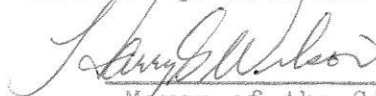
SECTION ONE: That Zoning Ordinance No. 1000 of the City of Redlands shall be amended by adopting Amendment No. 1 to Ordinance No. 1124 to read as follows:

"Section VI C. All trailers shall have toilet, bath, and sink facilities which shall be connected to the City's sanitary sewer line."

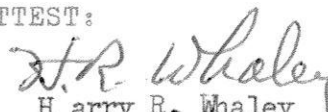
SECTION TWO: Before adopting this Ordinance, the City Council held a public hearing, notice of which was published in the City of Redlands on the 20 day of November, 1959, Ten days before the hearing.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this City.

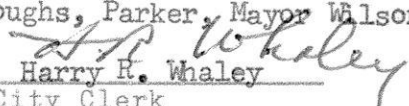
