

ORDINANCE NO. 1189

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1000 OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS BY ADOPTING ADDITIONAL LAND USE DISTRICT MAPS AS PART OF THE OFFICIAL LAND USE ZONING MAP AND EFFECTING A CHANGE OF ZONE. ZONE CHANGE NO. 45

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Public hearings having been held before the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands and the City Council of the City of Redlands pursuant to the California Conservation and Planning Act and Ordinance No. 1000 of the City of Redlands, the zone districts as shown on Land Use district Map entitled "City of Redlands Zoning Map," Supplemental Map No. 45 attached hereto, is hereby approved, and said Map is hereby adopted as a part of the Official Land Use Zone Map as provided in Section 9 of Ordinance No. 1000 and on file in the office of the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands.

SECTION 2. An adjustment of certain zone boundaries and a change of zone for certain properties as necessary and desirable in conjunction with the construction and completion of that portion of the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways which passes through the City of Redlands. (Said changes of zone and adjustments of zone boundaries being a logical extension of existing zones and in conformity with the General Plan.)

SECTION 3. Effective date: this ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this city.

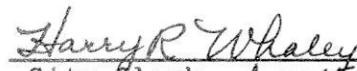
