

ORDINANCE NO. 2176

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING TITLE 18 OF THE REDLANDS MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADOPTING AN ADDITIONAL LAND USE ZONING PLAN AS PART OF THE OFFICIAL LAND USE ZONING MAP AND EFFECTING ZONE CHANGE NO. 339

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS does ordain:


SECTION 1. Public hearings having been held before the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands and the City Council of the City of Redlands pursuant to the California Conservation and Planning Act and Title 18 of the Redlands Municipal Code, the boundaries as shown on Supplement Map No. 339, attached hereto, are hereby approved and adopted as a part of the Official Land Use Zoning Map as provided for in Section 18.16.020 of the Redlands Municipal Code and on file in the Office of Planning and Community Development of the City of Redlands.


SECTION 2. This ordinance establishes a change of zone from A-1 (Agricultural) District and A-D (Airport) District to I-P (Industrial) District for approximately twenty-four acres of land located on the southwest corner of Sessums Drive and Wabash Avenue. Said change of zone would be in conformity with the General Plan.

SECTION 3. Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it, or a summary of it, to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this City.


