

ORDINANCE NO. 1222

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1000 OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS BY ADOPTING AMENDMENT NO. 42 THERETO.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Zoning Ordinance No. 1000 of the City of Redlands, be and is hereby amended by adopting Amendment No. 42 which amends a section as follows:

SECTION 6.20 - SPECIFIC DEFINITIONS

That pursuant to Sections 65800 and 65807 of the Government Code, Section 6.20 (Specific Definitions), is hereby amended by the following addition:

MILE - One (1) mile is defined as a linear distance of not less than 5,280 feet measured radially on a horizontal plane between the closest boundaries of the properties under consideration.

One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile is defined as a linear distance of not less than 2,640 feet measured radially on a horizontal plane between the closest boundaries of the properties under consideration.

SECTION TWO: Before adopting this ordinance, the City Council held a public hearing, notice of which was published in the City of Redlands on the 24th day of July, 1963, 13 days before the hearing.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Fact, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this city.
