A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE BOUNDARIES AS PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION NO. 3609

WHEREAS, the City of Redlands has established certain agricultural preserves; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redlands is authorized to establish agricultural preserves pursuant to the California Land Conservation Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, land to be included within the Agricultural Preserves is used for the purpose of producing agricultural commodities for commercial purposes and compatible uses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the real property located in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, as definitively set forth in the amended map prepared by the Department of Planning and Community Development, and filed on March 12, 1980 in Book 8, Page 90, of Miscellaneous Maps, Document No. _____, in the San Bernardino County Recorder's Office, which is incorporated by reference herein, is hereby designated and established as Agricultural Preserves within the meaning of and pursuant to the Land Conservation Act of 1965, as amended.

Parcel identified by July, 1979, San Bernardino County Assessor's Parcel Number 167-171-05 is therefore deleted from Agricultural Preserve as established by Resolution No. 3609.
