## RESOLUTION NO. 4003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE BOUNDARIES AS PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION NO. 3984

AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE REMOVALS NO. 61 & 63

WHEREAS, the City of Redlands has established certain agricultural preserves; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redlands is authorized to establish agricultural preserves pursuant to the California Land Conservation Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, land to be included within the Agricultural Preserves is used for the purpose of producing agricultural commodities for commercial purposes and compatible uses; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3649, adopted by the City Council of the City of Redlands on February 19, 1980, establishes policy criteria for removal of lands from within the Agricultural Preserves;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the real property located in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, as definitely set forth in the amended map prepared by the Department of Planning and Community Development and filed on November 20, 1984 in Book 9, Page 6, of Miscellaneous Maps, Document 84-279295, in the San Bernardino County Recorder's Office, which is incorporated by reference herein, is hereby designated and established as Agricultural Preserves within the meaning of and pursuant to the Land Conservation Act of 1965, as amended.

Parcels identified by July, 1984, San Bernardino County Assessor's No. 168-291-10 and No. 168-041-20 are therefore deleted from the Agricultural Preserve as established by Resolution No. 3984.
