

RESOLUTION NO. 808

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS CONCERNING AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redlands recognizes and declares that the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the people of Redlands requires purity and freedom of the air from atmospheric contamination and pollution;

WHEREAS, it is not practical or feasible to prevent or reduce air contaminants by local ordinances of the City of Redlands or other Cities located within the County of San Bernardino;

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has enacted legislation creating air pollution control districts having boundaries coextensive with the boundaries of every County of the State;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redlands declares that it is necessary to provide for air pollution control districts with County-wide authority in the event that regulations are necessary and feasible to reduce air contaminants and safeguard life, health, property and the public welfare and to make possible the comfortable enjoyment of life and property;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Redlands does hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER as follows:

SECTION 1. That this City Council hereby declares that local ordinances are not practical or feasible for effective air pollution control in the City of Redlands and the County of San Bernardino and that an Air Pollution Control District provides a more feasible and practical method of control;

SECTION 2. That this City Council hereby orders that a copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the Board of Supervisors of
