

RESOLUTION NO. 2092

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CLOSE ALL OF A CERTAIN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA. ALLEY VACATION NO. 30.

The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby resolves as follows:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 2 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and to vacate a certain alley in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: This City Council does hereby declare that it is the intention of this City Council to order the vacation of all of a certain alley in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

All that alley in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California being 13 feet in width and lying between Lot 7 and Lots 1, 2 and 3 of the Excelsior Tract as per plat recorded in Book 5 of Maps, page 40 thereof, extending from the westerly line of 80 foot wide Cajon Street to the westerly line of Lot 7 extended.

SECTION THREE: The Council hereby determines that the vacation of the alley described herein is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting out the particulars of the proposed alley vacation shall be on file in the office of the City Clerk and available for inspection by interested persons.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of Public Hearing of all matters concerning the above described proposed alley closing, and the time at which any person or agent should present any objections to the aforesaid alley vacation, at 7:00 P.M. on the 7th day of February, 1961, in the regular meeting place of the City Council in the City Hall, Redlands, California.
