

RESOLUTION NO. 4332

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO INITIATE ON ITS OWN MOTION
PROCEEDINGS TO ANNEX CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY
ANNEXATION NO. 60-D

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS:

1. That the City Council of the City of Redlands, for the reasons hereinafter mentioned, proposes to initiate on its own motion, as soon as it can legally do so, proceedings to annex to the City of Redlands all of the territory hereinafter described, as uninhabited territory, pursuant to the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code of the State of California.
2. That the City Council's reason for proposing to initiate said annexation proceedings are as follows: The annexation of the hereinafter described territory will contribute to the orderly growth of the City, provide the proper control of street layout, drainage, sanitary sewer design, and insure the proper use of land in conformity with the overall plan of the City.
3. That this proposal is consistent with the sphere of influence of the City of Redlands.
4. That the territory which the City Council proposes to annex is hereby identified as Annexation No. 60-D and consists of all that real property situated in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, and as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit B.

5. That the City Clerk of the City of Redlands is hereby directed to file with the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, this resolution that proceedings have been initiated to annex the herein above described uninhabited territory to the City of Redlands, to request a report by the Commission provided for by the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, and to submit and execute such other applications and reports as may be required by law in such annexation proceedings.

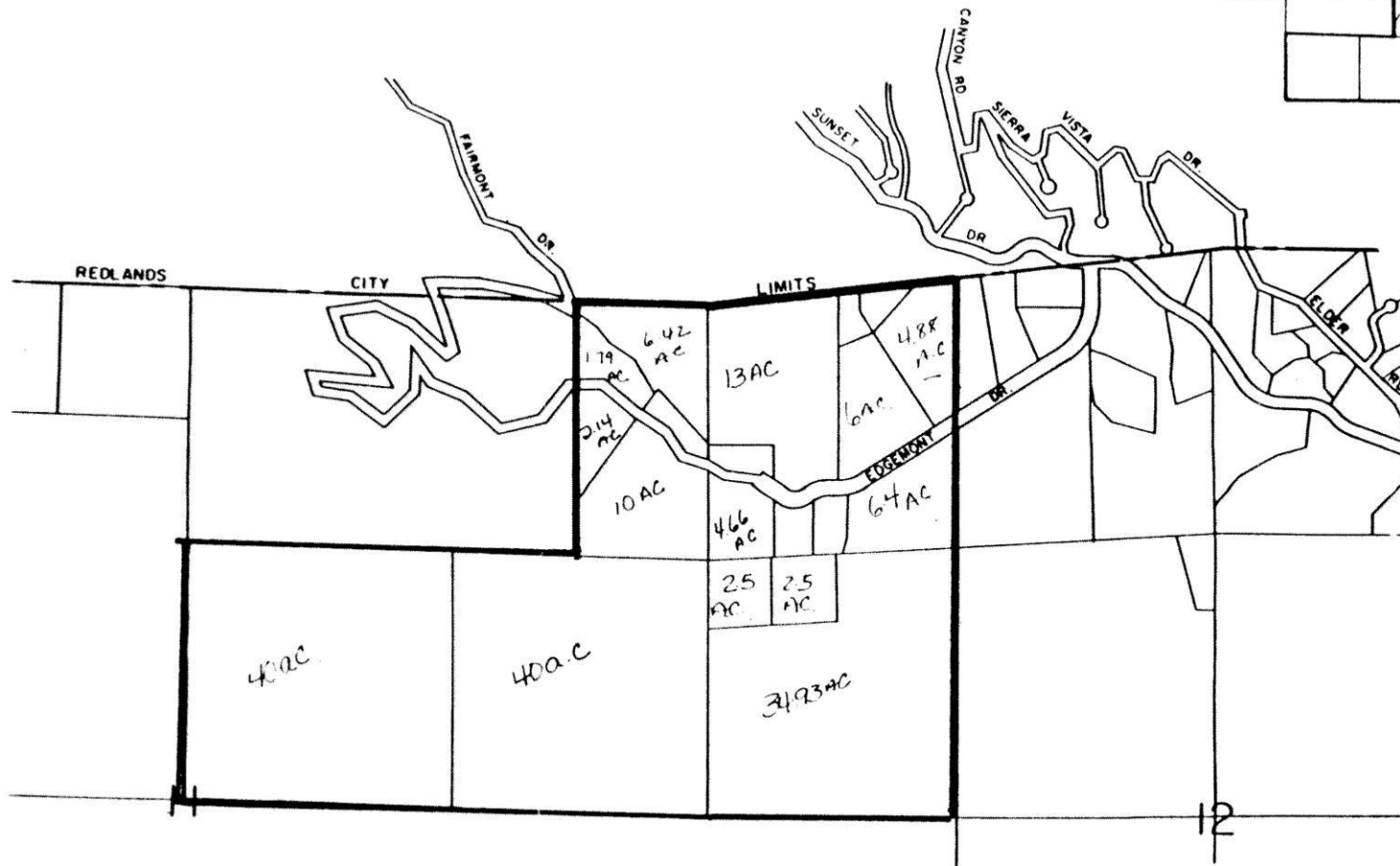

EXHIBIT A
LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Beginning at the intersection of the West line of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 11, T.2S., R.3W., S.B.M. with the South line of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 11; thence easterly along last said line to its intersection with the East line of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North east $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11; thence northerly along last said line to its intersection with the South line of the City of Redlands City Limits Line; thence easterly along last said line to its intersection with the West line of Government Lot 9 of Section 12, T.2S., R.3W., S.B.M; thence southerly along last said line and the West line of Government Lot 12 of said Section 12 to its intersection with the South line of Government Lot 11 of said Section 12; thence westerly along last said line and the South line of the North east $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11 to its intersection with said West line of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 11; thence northerly along last said line to the Point of Beginning.

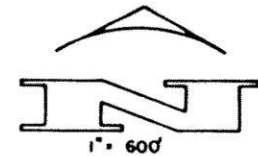
