

RESOLUTION NO. 618

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DIVIDING THE CITY
OF REDLANDS INTO FIVE CENSUS TRACTS.

Whereas the Bureau of Census of the Department of Commerce of the United States of America is to compute and take the census in this City of Redlands, and whereas the division of this City into census tracts will facilitate the taking of such census and will prove of value for analysis of future municipal problems,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that the City of Redlands be divided into five Census Tracts described as follows, to-wit:

That area designated as Section A shall be that portion of the incorporate city lying north of Central Avenue, west of Orange Street.

That area designated as Section B shall be that portion of the incorporate city lying east of Orange Street and north of a line beginning at the intersection of Orange Street and Central Avenue; thence east to Church Street; thence north on Church Street to the Santa Fe right-of-way; thence east along the Santa Fe right-of-way to the east city limits.

That area designated as Section C shall be that portion of the incorporate city lying within the incorporate city limits beginning at the intersection of Tennessee and Central Avenue; thence east along Central Avenue to Church Street; thence south on Church Street to Fern Avenue; thence southwesterly on Fern Avenue to Cajon Street; thence northwesterly on Cajon Street to Olive Avenue; thence southwesterly on Olive Avenue to Center; thence northwesterly on Center Street to Brookside Avenue; thence southwesterly on Brookside Avenue to Tennessee Street extended; thence north on Tennessee Street to Central Avenue to point of beginning.

That area designated as Section D shall encompass that property bounded within the area described as follows: From the intersection of Center Street and Olive Avenue east along Olive Avenue to Cajon Street; thence south on Cajon Street to Fern Avenue; thence east on Fern Avenue to Highway 99 (Beacon Street extended); thence southeasterly along Highway 99 to Palm Avenue; thence southwesterly along Palm Avenue to Center Street; thence northwesterly on Center Street to Olive Avenue to point of beginning.

That area designated as Section E shall be all of the incorporate city limits lying south of the irregular line described as: Beginning at the west city limits at Brookside Avenue; thence northeasterly to Center Street; thence southeasterly on Center Street to Palm Avenue; thence northeasterly on Palm Avenue to Highway 99; thence northwesterly on Highway 99 to junction of Church Street and Fern Avenue; thence north on Church Street to the Santa Fe right-of-way; thence east on the Santa Fe right-of-way to the east city limits at Wabash.

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Redlands, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 5th day of August, 1948.
