Claim for Damages

George E. Goldie and Lydia Goldie, pursuant to Sections 5149 and 5150 of the General Laws of the State of California, present to the City of Redlands and to the City Council of the City of Redlands the following claim for damages, to-wit:

A claim for damages done to citrus trees and crop thereon and to certain trees constituting a windbreak situate on the property of the said claimants at the head of Church Street and adjacent to the Redlands city dump in the City of Redlands, State of California, which said damages were caused by the maintenance of the Redlands city dump in a dangerous condition and/or by the negligent and careless acts of the employees or servants or agents of the City of Redlands at the said dump, or by the negligent and careless acts of Vaughn H. Alchian acting as agent or as lessee or as employee or as sub-contractor of the City of Redlands or by an employee or servant of the said Vaughn H. Alchian.

That the said dangerous condition maintained at the Redlands city dump and the negligent and careless acts of the parties above mentioned were known to the officials of the City of Redlands.

That the said damage was to the best knowledge of claimants caused as follows: By fire escaping from the city dump and burning the citrus trees and trees constituting the windbreak thereon; that the said damage was in the amount of \$300.00.
