

NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS NO. 294.

Pursuant to statute and the resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 28th day of August, 1911, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office in the City Hall building, in said city, up to two o'clock p. m. on the 20th day of September, 1911, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file, adopted for said work, or herein mentioned, to-wit:

First:—That the roadway of East Colton Avenue between the gutter lines thereof from the asphalt on the east line of Orange street to the center line of Church Street, including all intersections of streets, shall be graded to the official grade and macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made, and the construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters upon the north side of East Colton Avenue, from Times Street to Church Street, excepting where such curbs and gutters are already in to the official grade of said street and except street intersections, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor, on file in the office of said City Engineer, to all of which reference is hereby made.

It is hereby determined, in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7th, 1911, that serial bonds shall be issued to represent assessments of twenty-five Dollars or over, for the cost of said work or improvement, said bonds shall be serial, extending over a period of nine years, from the second day of January, next succeeding their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January every year after their date, until the whole is paid, and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupon on the second days of January and July respectively, of each year, at the rate of even per cent per annum, on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and interest are paid.

Said bonds shall be issued in manner and form, as provided by said act.

Second:—That the roadway of East Colton Avenue between the gutter lines thereof, from the center line of Church street to the center line of University street, produced North across Colton Avenue, including all intersections of street, shall be graded to the official grade and macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made; and the construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters upon the north and south side of East Colton Avenue from Church Street to University street, except where such curbs and gutters are already in to the official grade of said street, and except street intersections, all as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

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ing their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January every year after their date, until the whole is paid, and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupon on the second days of January and July respectively, of each year, at the rate of seven per cent per annum on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said bonds shall be issued in the manner and form as provided by said Act.

Third:—That the Roadway of East Colton Avenue, between the gutter lines thereof, from the center line of University Street to the West line of

Cook Street; produced North across Colton Avenue, including all intersections of streets, shall be graded to the official grade and shall be macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made and the construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters upon the north and south sides of East Colton Avenue from University Street to the West line of Cook Street, produced north across Colton Avenue, except where such curbs and gutters are already in to the official grade of said street and excepting street intersections all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross sections and specifications therefor, all on file in the office of said City Engineer, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Fourth:—The construction of stone curbs, concrete gutters and cement sidewalks upon both sides of Columbia Street from the North line of Colton Avenue to the South line of Union Avenue, except at street intersections and at places where such curbs, gutters and sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all as shown upon and in accordance with plans, cross-sections, profiles and specifications for said work on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Fifth:—The construction of stone curbs, concrete gutters and cement sidewalks upon both sides of Ninth Street from the North line of State Avenue, except at street intersections, and at places where such curbs, gutters and sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all as shown upon and in accordance with plans, cross-sections, profiles and specifications for said work all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Bidders must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to said city, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Bids will be opened on the 20th day of September, 1911, at 2 o'clock.

NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT No. 294

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted on the 20th day of September, 1911, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

First: The construction of stone curbs, concrete gutters and cement sidewalks upon both sides of Columbia street from the north line of Colton Avenue to the south line of Union Avenue, except at street intersections and at places where such curbs, gutters and sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all as shown upon and in accordance with plans, cross sections, profiles and specifications for said work on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Second: The construction of stone curbs, concrete gutters and cement sidewalks upon both sides of Ninth street from the north line of State street to the south line of Central Avenue, except at street intersections, and at places where such curbs, gutters and sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all as shown upon and in accordance with plans, cross sections, profiles, and specifications for said work all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 20th day of September, 1911, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit, W. M. Adams, at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: 12 cents per square foot for sidewalk work and 40 cents per lineal foot for curb and gutter work all complete.
