

RESOLUTION NO. 537

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDLANDS REQUESTING STATE FUNDS BE
ALLOCATED FOR EMERGENCY FLOOD PROTECTION WORK
FROM THE STATE EMERGENCY FUND CREATED BY
CHAPTER 11, STATUTES OF 1938, EXTRA SESSION S Bd-2.

TO THE HONORABLE FRANK F. MERRIAM, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF
CALIFORNIA:

WHEREAS this community was subjected to a storm of unprecedented
magnitued in the first week of March of this year which destroyed
all of the protection work and walls constructed by this
community during the past thirty years for the flood protection
of this City on Mill Creek, a tributary of Santa Ana River, and
WHEREAS this storm filled the old channel of Mill Creek with an
enormous quantity of large boulders and heavy debris so that there
is now a present existing danger of the said stream of Mill
Creek changing its course and following an old channel over
which the business district of the City of Redlands now stands, and
WHEREAS the property within the City of Redlands exposed to the
danger of flood damages should even a minor storm arise, is of
the value in excess of \$1,500,000.00, and
WHEREAS it is necessary to the safety of life and property that
the said Mill Creek Channel be cleared of debris and dredged
to relieve the present existing emergency danger, and
WHEREAS it is estimated that the clearing of the debris and
dredging of the channel will require excavation and removal of 400000
cubic yards of rock, boulders, and sand, all of which material
to be deposited in a dike along the south bank of said Mill Creek,
according to plans now on file with the State Engineer, at an
estimated cost of \$.35 per yard and will amount to the sum of
\$14,000.00 and WHEREAS the City of Redlands has exhausted all its
moneys available for storm protection work for the present fiscal
year, the City Council of the City of Redlands deems it advisable
to immediately request an allocation from the Emergency State
Fund created by Chapter 11, Statutes of 1938, Extra Session, for
the above mentioned emergency project.
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City
of Redlands, request, and it is hereby requested, that the
Honorable Frank F. Merriam, Governor of the State of California
allocate the sum of \$14,000.00 from the Emergency Fund created
by Chapter 11, Statutes of 1938, Extra Session, S.Bd.-2, for the
above mentioned project.
