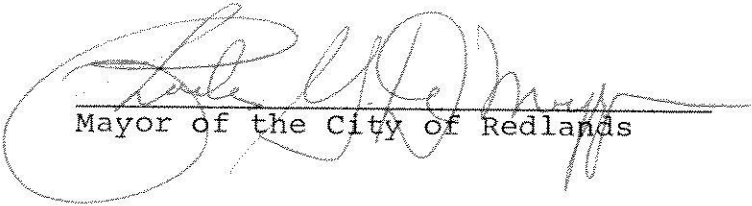

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

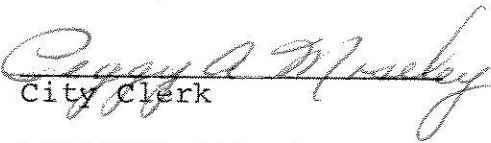
That the City Council of the City of Redlands does hereby amend Resolution No. 3418 and 3396 as follows:
