

Ordinance 788, Section 46: Sub. Section 8

It shall be unlawful for any person within said city; To open, or attempt to open any fire hydrant in the City of Redlands without first obtaining a permit so to do from the Chief of the Fire Department.

RESOLUTION No. 580

Any person, firm or corporation using any fire hydrant connected to the water mains of the City of Redlands, for the purpose of spraying shall be subject to the following regulations and rates:

1. A permit shall be obtained from the Chief of the Fire Department for each hydrant, stating the hydrant and the length of time it is to be used. ( No permit shall be valid for more than ten days)
2. A service charge of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be made for each such permit issued.
3. Water shall be paid for at the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) *per rig.* per Diem or portion thereof by any person, firm or corporation using fire hydrants for such purpose. Payment for such water to be made to the Fire Department when permit is obtained.
