

1 RESOLUTION NO. 802

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 REDLANDS COMMENDING CONGRESSMAN EDGAR HIESTAND FOR THE INTRODUCTION
4 OF LEGISLATION FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR FIRE PREVENTION IN
5 THE FORESTS OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA.

6 WHEREAS, Congressman Edgar Hiestand recently proposed a
7 certain piece of legislation calling for the allocation of One
8 Million Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars for fire pre-
9 vention in the forests of Southern California, and

10 WHEREAS, if there had been proper fire prevention equip-
11 ment and personnel in the past in the mountain areas of Southern
12 California there would be less present need and/or demand for
13 appropriations for flood control.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
15 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AS FOLLOWS:

16 SECTION ONE: That the City of Redlands through its
17 Mayor and City Council does hereby commend Congressman Edgar
18 Hiestand and expresses its appreciation to him for the intro-
19 duction of this legislation, and does hereby go on record as
20 unanimously supporting this legislation.

21 SECTION TWO: That a certified copy of this resolution
22 be presented to Congressman Edgar Hiestand.
