RESOLUTION NO. 3143

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF REDLANDS, SUPPORTING PLAN "F" OF THE U. S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR THE CONTROL OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER

WHEREAS: The City of Redlands is bordered on the north by the Santa Ana River; and

WHEREAS: The property and lives of many residents are subject to hazards of possible flooding; and

WHEREAS: The City owns and operates facilities along the bank of the Santa Ana River; and

WHEREAS: Flooding has occurred in the past, endangering private property and public-owned facilities; and

WHEREAS: The U. S. Corps of Engineers has developed several alternate proposals for the control of the Santa Ana River, the said proposals being contained in the publication entitled "Information Brochure, Alternative Proposals for Flood Control and Allied Purposes" and dated August, 1974; and

WHEREAS: Alternate Plan "F" in the above-mentioned brochure will provide flood protection for the City of Redlands from the Santa Ana River; and

WHEREAS: The U. S. Corps of Engineers must demonstrate to the Congress of the United States that their plan has public support;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Redlands, California, hereby supports Alternate Plan "F" for the control of the Santa Ana River as described in the aforementioned brochure.
