

RESOLUTION NO. 2824

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
FOR ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 12 TO THE GENERAL PLAN

Whereas the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands has prepared an amendment to the General Plan and adopted such amendment in Resolution R.P.C. No. 322 after holding a public hearing upon notice in accordance with the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 322, a copy of which is attached hereto, has been certified to the City Council of the City of Redlands; and

WHEREAS on the 11th day of July, 1970, notice of Public Hearing was published in the Redlands Daily Facts; and

WHEREAS on this 21st day of July, 1970, the City Council has held a duly advertised public hearing concerned with the proposed amendment to said General Plan; and

WHEREAS following said Public Hearing the City Council declares that the proposed amendment is in the interest of the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS all of the provisions of the Government Code relating to the amendment of a general plan have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redlands;

That the amendment to the General Plan adopted by the Planning Commission in Resolution No. 322 shall be adopted as follows:

AMENDMENT NO. 12 TO THE
GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

1. That a diagram entitled General Plan Street Rights-of-Way and Pavement Widths and identified with the index title of GP-6, on file in the office of the Planning Department, is hereby adopted.

RESOLUTION R.P.C. NO. 322

RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 12
TO THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

W H E R E A S on this 23rd day of June, 1970, the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands finds:

1. It is deemed advisable and necessary to amend the General Plan Street Rights-of-Way and Pavement Widths diagrams. Said amendment reorganizes the order of street cross-sections, changes the nomenclature of certain street cross-sections, deletes setback lines from the street cross-sections, and modifies the 50 foot right-of-way residential street cross-section.
2. On the 12th day of June, 1970, Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Redlands Daily Facts.
3. On the 23rd day of June, 1970, the Planning Commission held a duly advertised public hearing concerning the proposed amendment to the General Plan.
4. Following said public hearing the Planning Commission declares that the proposed amendment is in the interest of the public health, safety, and general welfare.
5. All provisions of the California Government Code relating to the amendment of the General Plan have been complied with.

N O W, T H E R E F O R E, B E I T R E S O L V E D:
