

RESOLUTION NO. 3083

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
FOR ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 18 TO THE GENERAL PLAN

WHEREAS the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands has prepared an amendment to the General Plan and adopted such amendment in Resolution R.P.C. No. 397 after holding a public hearing upon notice in accordance with the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 397, a copy of which is attached hereto, has been certified to the City Council of the City of Redlands; and

WHEREAS on the 5th day of January, 1974, notice of Public Hearing was published in the Redlands Daily Facts; and

WHEREAS on this 15th day of January, 1974, the City Council has held a duly advertised public hearing concerned with the proposed amendment to said General Plan; and

WHEREAS following said Public Hearing the City Council declares that the proposed amendment is in the interest of the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS all of the provisions of the Government Code relating to the amendment of a general plan have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redlands;

That the amendment to the General Plan adopted by the Planning Commission in Resolution No. 397 shall be adopted as follows:

AMENDMENT NO. 18 TO THE
GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

1. That the amended General Plan for the City of Redlands and a General Plan report entitled Open Space and Conservation Elements of the General Plan, identified with the index title of GP-10, and on file in the office of the Planning Department, are hereby adopted.

RESOLUTION R.P.C. NO. 397
RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 18 TO THE
GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

- W H E R E A S the California State Legislature has adopted into law a requirement that each city and county shall adopt open space and conservation elements as a part of its General Plan;
- W H E R E A S the Planning Department has completed studies in accordance with State requirements;
- W H E R E A S on the 16th day of November, 1973, notice of public hearing was published in the Redlands Daily Facts;
- W H E R E A S on the 27th day of November, 1973, the Planning Commission held a duly advertised public hearing concerning the proposed amendment to the General Plan.
- W H E R E A S following said public hearing the Planning Commission declares that the proposed amendment is in the interest of public health, safety, and general welfare.
- W H E R E A S all the provisions of the California Government Code relating to the amendment of the General Plan have been complied with.

by the Planning Commission of the City of Redlands:

- A. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 65302(d), 65302(e), and 65560 et seq. of the California Government Code, the Planning Commission hereby adopts on this 27th day of November, 1973, Amendment No. 18 to the General Plan of the City of Redlands.
- B. That a report entitled Open Space and Conservation Elements of the General Plan and identified with the index title of GP-10 is on file in the office of the Planning Department.
- C. That the Planning Commission hereby recommends that the City Council of the city of Redlands, following the required public hearing, approve and adopt said Amendment No. 18.
- D. That a certified copy of the report and of this resolution shall be transmitted to the City Council.
