**WHEREAS**, the Department of Justice has made available through the State Domestic Preparedness Needs Assessment and Equipment Program, grant funds;

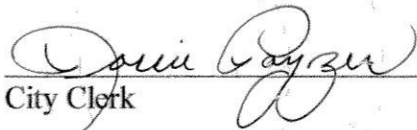

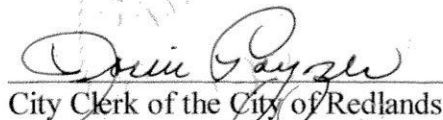
