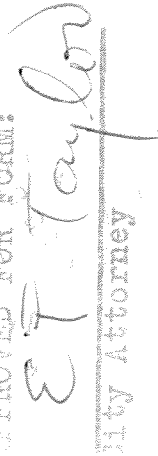

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE GOVERNING
BOARD OF REDLANDS SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SAN BERNARDINO
COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, HELD ON THE 9th DAY OF
DECEMBER, 1958

The Board met in regular session on the 9th day of December, 1958, at the usual meeting place thereof. The President called the meeting to order at

3:00 o'clock P.M. On roll call the following members were present, namely:

The adoption of the following resolution and order was moved by Member Cranmer, and seconded by Member Marcum and a vote being taken, the said resolution and order was adopted by the following votes of members present: AYES: Members Kahl, Cranmer, Marcum, Poston

RESOLUTION AND ORDER AUTHORIZING DEDICATION OF
REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF REDLANDS FOR
PUBLIC PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of November, 1958, this Governing Board determined by resolution duly and regularly adopted to dedicate to the City of Redlands, a municipal corporation and a political subdivision of the State of California, for public purposes certain real property, hereinafter described, belonging to the Redlands School District of San Bernardino County, California, upon consideration that said City shall pay all costs incidental to such dedication, including the cost of the necessary legal publication of said resolution; and

WHEREAS, by said Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property, adopted as aforesaid, it was provided that not less than ten (10) days subsequent to the adoption thereof, to-wit: on the 9th day of December, 1958, a public meeting of the Governing Board of said School District would be held at its regular place of meeting at the Board Room of 33 W. Lugonia Avenue, Redlands, California, at which meeting a public hearing would be had upon the question of making the dedication and at which meeting objections and protests thereto, if any, would be received and considered; and,

WHEREAS, at the regular public meeting of said Governing Board of said School District held at the time and place heretofore determined and fixed by

said Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property, as aforesaid, not less than ten (10) days intervened between the date of adoption of such Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property and the date therein set for the meeting and public hearing upon the question of making the dedication and for the receipt and consideration of objections and protest thereto, if any; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the adoption of said Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property, as aforesaid, and of the time and place of holding the meeting and public hearing upon the question of making the dedication and for the receipt and consideration of objections and protests, if any, has been given by posting copies of said Resolution signed by the Governing Board of said School District, or by a majority thereof, in three public places in the district, not less than ten (10) days before the date therein set for such meeting and public hearing, as will appear more fully from the affidavit of posting attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof by reference as if fully herein set forth; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the adoption of said Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property, as aforesaid, and of the time and place of holding the meeting and public hearing upon the question of making the dedication and for the receipt and consideration of objections and protests, if any, has been given by publishing such resolution and notice once, not less than five (5) days before the date of said public meeting in a newspaper of general circulation published in said School District as will appear more fully from the affidavit of publication attached hereto, marked "Exhibit B" and made a part hereof by reference as if fully herein set forth; and,

WHEREAS, no objections or protests to said dedication have been made or filed with said Governing Board of said School District; and,

WHEREAS, no petition protesting against the proposed dedication signed by at least ten (10) percent of the qualified electors of said School District, as shown by the affidavit of one of the petitioners has been filed with said Governing Board at the public meeting held at the time and place heretofore fixed in said Resolution of Intention to Dedicate Real Property, as aforesaid,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the hereinafter described real property belonging to said School District be, and it is hereby dedicated to the City of Redlands, a municipal corporation, and a political subdivision of the State of California, for public purposes, upon consideration that said City

shall pay all costs incidental to such dedication, including the cost of the necessary legal publication of the resolution of intention to dedicate said real property, and the president of the Governing Board of said School District, or other presiding officer or the members thereof, are hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed of dedication of the hereinafter described real property to the City of Redlands, a municipal corporation and a political subdivision of the State of California, and to deliver said deed to the City Council of the City of Redlands, California for acceptance by said City forthwith upon the payment of the considerations as aforesaid by said City to said School District.

The real property so dedicated pursuant to this resolution and order is described as all the certain real property situated in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Easterly 10 feet of lots 1, and 1½ of Block X, Addition #5 Map of Redlands,

IN WITNESS, of the passage of the foregoing resolution and order in the form and manner prescribed by law, we, the members of said Board present and voting thereon, have hereunto set our hands this 9th day of December, 1958.
