

RESOLUTION NO. 4647

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
TO SUPPORT H.R. 3389, THE BILLBOARD CONTROL ACT OF 1989**

WHEREAS, H.R. 3389, the Billboard Control Act of 1989 was introduced by Congressman John Lewis of Georgia on October 2, 1989;

WHEREAS, H.R. 3389, returns to states and local governments the right to regulate existing billboards under their own land use laws;

WHEREAS, H.R. 3389 , places a moratorium on new billboard construction along interstates and federal primary aide highways;

WHEREAS, H.R. 3389, shall find a State to be in non-compliance if vegetation, located on any land on which the State owns a right-of-way, is allowed to be cut, altered, or removed for the purpose of improving the visibility of any outdoor advertising sign, display, or device; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Redlands does hereby support H.R. 3389;

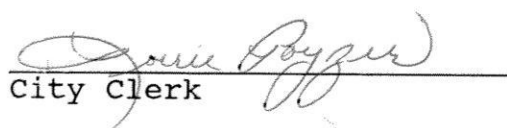
